

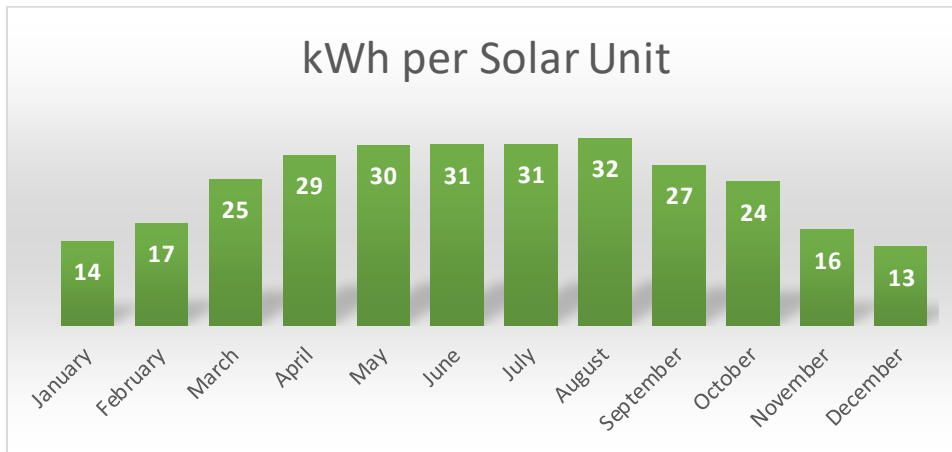
Community Solar FAQs

How much does it cost to participate in the Community Solar program?

Customers can subscribe to solar units by either paying a monthly flat fee of \$3.96 for each unit, or by paying a one-time fee of \$1049.70.

How much energy will my solar units produce?

Each solar unit is estimated to produce between 13 and 32kWh per month. Several factors including cloud cover and system maintenance may impact the actual production of each unit.



How long is the commitment term for each subscription?

Monthly subscriptions require a one (1) year commitment for subscriptions of less than 200 units and a five (5) year commitment for subscriptions of 200 units or more.

One-Time subscriptions require a twenty-five (25) year commitment.

Can I gift my solar units to other FPB customers?

Customers that subscribe to solar units by paying the one-time capacity fee may transfer their units one time during the term of the agreement.

Are there limits to the number of units I can subscribe to?

Subscriptions are limited to 60 solar units for residential customers and 200 units for commercial, municipal, and large power.

Tentative plan is to go live in August, allow sign-ups in September (contract required) and customers would see credits/charges on their October bill
